Charlier Associates completed a traffic and parking demand analysis for the Jackson Community Center for the Arts (CCA) for inclusion in the CCA's Final Development Plan Application submission to the Town of Jackson. The proposed 95,000 square foot CCA building will house offices for multiple agencies, studios, art classes, two large theatres, a gallery and a clubhouse. As part of the project, CAI analyzed the impacts on the surrounding street system of the traffic generated by the CCA. In addition, CAI developed a shared parking analysis for the site as a whole by identifying the parking needs of each CCA use and activity. In order to determine shared parking possibilities for periods when CCA parking demand exceeds its available on-site parking capacity, CAI also developed a shared parking analyses for off-street surface parking lots within walking distance of the CCA site. Using the results of the analyses, CAI offered various recommendations for the management of parking on the CCA site. CAI also provided technical advice on the CCA site design to improve the relationship between on-site pedestrian pathways and pedestrian travel from surrounding neighborhoods.
