

ACCESS AND CIRCULATION STUDY FOR DOWNTOWN GREELEY

GREELEY, COLORADO (COMPLETED)

Charlier Associates helped the City of Greeley and the Greeley Downtown Development Authority (DDA) develop an access and circulation plan that would encourage and support the redevelopment of their downtown core area. Like many of smaller towns and cities along the Front Range of Colorado, many of the traditional downtown businesses and public agencies have left the downtown area over the past two decades. The City of Greeley and the DDA have begun to address this issue and recently finished a plan that addresses economic strategies needed to catalyze downtown redevelopment. CAI developed recommendations, based on that plan, to improve multimodal access and circulation to and with the downtown area including recommendations for improvements to the network of streets, sidewalks, bikeways, transit routes and urban design features.
