TRANSIT DESIGN STANDARDS AND CUSTOMER FACILITIES MANUAL

Fort Collins, Colorado (completed 2001)

Charlier Associates updated the City of Fort Collins' existing Transit Design Standards and developed a Customer Amenities Manual for the City's transit agency, Transfort. Priorities included: developing standards that are clear to planners, developers and interested citizens; establishing a hierarchy of transit stops and service; better integrating the bicycle and bus system; and improving the overall attractiveness of transit to area residents.

CAI sought to integrate the manual with existing City documents, such as the comprehensive plan, street standards and land use code. The result was a single comprehensive manual that details transit stop design requirements, such as pullouts, shelters, accessibility, signage, lighting and landscaping.



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
