JACKSON HOLE TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN

Charlier Associates prepared a comprehensive, regional, multimodal transportation plan for the Town of Jackson and Teton County. CAI's work included a resident travel diary, visitor travel survey, traffic model coordination with Wyoming Department of Transportation, regional traffic forecasts, level of service standards and design of an ongoing program of monitoring and reporting transportation system performance.

Working with various study groups and committees CAI developed multimodal goals and objectives, roadway capacity analysis, a transit system evaluation, and updates to local bicycle and pedestrian plans. The Transportation Plan, adopted in 2000, became Chapter 8 of the Regional Comprehensive Plan and serves as the basis for decision-making with respect to roadway improvements, transit system development and enhancement of the regional pathways network. CAI continues to provide on-demand services to the Town and County as requested.
